

## JOURNAL N°5 – “Canopée lumineuse / lightness held in tension”

*(Maquette de toiture – surface réglée)*

### MATERIAL

Wooden sticks: thin, flexible, rectilinear

Air: the real mass between each line

Shadow: changing with the time

Light: held gently by the grid

Ground: distant, untouched by volume

### TOOLS

Wooden sticks

Cutter

Ruler

Glue

Patience

Eyes in motion

### GESTURE

Align . Repeat . Adjust . Angle . Cross . Let float . Step back.

### THOUGHT

“Canopée volante” is not about structure. It is about the sensation of structure. It suggests shelter

— but it leaves the sky open. It builds rhythm — but never closure.
