MATERIAL

Ropes: flexible but firm

Patterns: complexity from necessity

TOOLS

Hands

Time

Knot diagrams

Anchor points

Patience

“To tie is to choose. To connect, and to trust.”

GESTURE

Loop . Tighten . Anchor . Repeat . Adapt . Untie . Rebuild.

REFLECTION

The difference between a knot and a mess is intention. Each technique speaks: fluidity, tension, stability.
